

Job description - Harvesting machine operator (PB6a)

Job summary

As Harvesting Machine Operator, you will help deliver the district's business plan by efficiently using forestry harvesting and extraction machines. You will use purpose-built forestry machines working as part of a dedicated team to plan and carry out tree harvesting.

You will operate a forwarder and harvester to mechanically fell trees and extract timber to roadside. You will work closely with the harvesting team and management to plan operations, meet district targets for outputs and specifications and ensure all health and safety issues are addressed.

Key responsibilities & accountabilities

- fell and forward trees during clear fell and thinning
- complete your operations in line with health, safety and environmental standards using tools such as site management plans and risk assessments
- · maintain machines liaising with the workshop as required
- work with the forester and works supervisor to maintain stock control by measuring roadside and on- site timber

And any other tasks, reasonably requested by your line manager.
